VOLANDRI TAKES CHALLENGER CROWN, CZECHS DEFEND

No. 2 seed Filippo Volandri denies Alejandro Gonzalez an undefeated finish to the ATP Challenger Tour Finals to claim the title in Sao Paulo. In a rematch of their Wednesday round-robin encounter (which Gonzalez won), Volandri recovered from an early deficit to win his 12th title on the Challenger circuit, becoming the ninth active player to accomplish the feat. Volandri wins \$84,900 and 110 points to bring him inside the Top

70 for the first time since April 2012.

The Czech Republic claimed its second straight Davis Cup title Sunday as Radek Stepanek became the third player in Davis Cup final round history to win two live fifth singles rubbers and the first ever to do so in consecutive finals. The Czech Republic is the first "away" team to win the Davis Cup since Spain won in 2008 in Argentina. Interim Captain Vladimir Safarik paid respects to Captain Jaroslav Navratil, who was unable to lead the team after being hospitalized with a pulmonary embolism last week.

2013 BARCLAYS ATP WORLD TOUR FINALS DELIVERS RECORD AUDIENCES

The 2013 Barclays ATP World Tour Finals provided yet another thrilling final chapter to a historic ATP World Tour season as sell-out crowds and record audiences online and on television tuned in to watch the top eight players battle for the last title of the season at The O2.

A capacity crowd of 17,800 last Monday evening witnessed defending champion Novak Djokovic defeat World No.1 Rafael Nadal for the title and a record \$1.92m in prize money. Overall attendance across the eight days of the tournament reached 261,247. It is the second consecutive year that the event has welcomed more than 260,000 fans.



broadcasters in 193 territories and received more than 13 million visitors (an increase of 9% on 2012) to its digital platforms via the new responsive-designed tournament website. The tournament's mobile traffic grew more than 100%, while more than half a million people watched Holding Court Live presented by Barclays which was streamed twice-daily from the Fan Zone at The O2. Live match streaming on TennisTV.com received more than 4.5 million total streams, an increase of 20%.

Since moving to London in 2009, the eight-day tournament has welcomed a remarkable 1.28 million fans to The O2 arena.

The deal gives non-exclusive TV and full radio commentary rights, with eight singles matches on TV, including a semifinal and the final. The BBC "has also secured non-exclusive live radio and online rights to all ATP World Tour Masters 1000 matches.

Boris Becker will partner with the new global agency Doyen and to focus on developing the company's presence in tennis. Becker said, "The team at Doyen has worked with some of the very top talent globally and we will both mutually benefit from working closely together." Doyen Global was set up this April by former executives from XIX Entertainment and Creative Artist Agency and recently announced an image rights agreement with Brazilian footballer Neymar earlier this year.

On his record-setting run of clinching two consecutive Davis Cup Finals in the live fifth rubber, **Radek Stepanek** commented, "I don't think words can describe it. To defend this trophy means the world for us right now. For our country, waiting 32 years for a second title, now we are one of the five countries who have been able to defend a title."

Rafael Nadal clinched the year-end No. 1 Emirates ATP Ranking for a third time at the Barclays ATP World Tour Finals. Nadal previously finished at the top in 2008 and 2010, and becomes the first player to hold, lose and regain the year-end No. 1 Emirates ATP Ranking on two occasions. This is the 10th straight season that the year-end World No. 1 ranking has been held by Nadal (2008, '10, '13), Federer (2004-07, '09) or Novak Djokovic (2011-12). **Roger Federer** received three honors in the 2013 ATP



World Tour Awards presented by Moët & Chandon in an on-court ceremony at the Barclays ATP World Tour Finals. He was selected by his peers as the winner of the Stefan Edberg Sportsmanship Award for a ninth time and by fans as the ATPWorldTour.com Fans' Favourite presented by Moët & Chandon for an 11th straight year. Additionally, the 32-



year-old Swiss was named the Arthur Ashe Humanitarian of the Year for a second time (also 2006) in recognition of his foundation's support of children in Africa and Switzerland. Since 2003, Federer has won a record total of 27 ATP World Tour Awards. The **Bryan Brothers** also accepted a trophy at the Barclays ATP World Tour Finals, seen above posing with their year-end No. 1 trophy. Along with the Bryans, **Pablo Carreno Busta** and **Jiri Vesely** were honored in the O2 for their breakthroughs on tour this year as Most Improved Player of the Year and ATP Star of Tomorrow, respectively.



Additionally, **this year's Season Finale final matchup** was the fifth No. 1 vs No. 2-ranked final in the season finale since the Emirates ATP Rankings began in 1973. It's the second year in a row and third time in the past four years the top two players are meeting in the final. Here is a look at the previous 1-2 finals: (No.2 players now lead 3-2)

FIRST STAGE OF STUTTGART CHANGE TO GRASS COMPLETE

Work is well underway at TC Weissenhof for the MercedesCup's switch from a clay- to grass-court ATP World Tour 250 tournament, set to debut in June 2015. Over the past three months, Courts 12, 13 and 18 have been rebuilt in consultation with the All England Club. Stands are being erected around Court 18.

"The soil structure and grass mixture we are using in Stuttgart is equal to Wimbledon", said Christian Engelmann, CEO of Engelmann Golfplatzpflege GmbH, the company in charge for the retrofitting. "We would like to thank the All England Lawn Tennis Club for their excellent support. If everything progresses well and stays on schedule, the first three grass courts in Stuttgart will be ready for play end of May 2014."

Laurent Delanney, CEO ATP Europe, said, "It is pleasing that the initial stages of the transition from clay to grass are going well. The MercedesCup was awarded an ATP grass court event after presenting a thorough application and we have great confidence that the organizers will deliver a high-level ATP grass court event in the lead up to Wimbledon."

On July 7, 2014, former Wimbledon champions John McEnroe and Michael Stich will contest an exhibition match on Mercedes Court, formerly Court 18, with a capacity of 2,000 seats. By 2015, Center Court and EnBW Court will also be converted to grass courts.

ATP To Raise Prize Money in Lowest Category Challenger

In 2014, a multi-year project will begin at the Challenger level. In keeping with our goals to promote, grow and increase the popularity of the game for the benefit of player and tournament members, the ATP will start this process by increasing the lowest category of Challenger tournaments. The Prize Money increase will

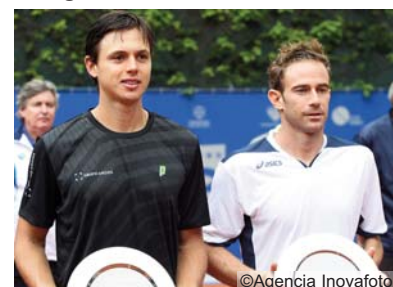


be from \$35,000+H/€30,000+H to \$40,000+H/€35,000+H, starting January 1st, 2014.

The increase in prize money will not be the only change to look forward to in 2014 and in future seasons. The ATP plans to create a more balanced schedule by enhancing regional swings at the Challenger level. **To read the full Challenger Prize Money note, visit the PlayerZone.**

Challenger Tour Finals

After his defeat to Filippo Volandri in the Challenger Tour Finals finale, Alejandro Gonzalez becomes just the sixth Colombian-born player to crack the Top 100 of the Emirates ATP Rankings. Volandri concludes his 2013 ATP Challenger Tour campaign with a 29-6 run since mid-July. His three titles are a career-high in a single season, having also won in Milan and Orbetello.

Qualifying Requirements

Singles Players: A minimum of 125 and a maximum of 160 singles players qualify for a year of service in the ATP Retirement Program provided that they:

- Are ATP player members in good standing.
- Play 11 main draw ATP World Tour tournaments* . If fewer than 125 players qualify using this criteria, the balance up to 125 will be made up of players with the next highest number of ATP World Tour tournaments played (10, 9, 8...etc.).
- In the event of a tie for the last position(s), priority will be given to participants with the highest number of points obtained at ATP World Tour tournaments during the year.
- Ties in points are broken as follows:
 1. The most total points from the ATP World Tour 1000 mandatory tournaments and Barclays ATP World Tour Finals main draws, and if still tied, then,
 2. The highest number of points from one single ATP World Tour tournament, then if needed, the second highest, and so on

Doubles Players: Up to 40 doubles players, who have not already qualified for the plan as singles participants, may qualify for a year of service in the ATP Retirement Program provided that they:

- Are ATP player members in good standing.
- Play a minimum of 11 main draw ATP World Tour doubles tournaments*.
- If more than 40 players satisfy the above requirements, priority will be given to participants with the highest number of points obtained at ATP World Tour doubles tournaments during the year
- Ties are broken as follows:
 1. The fewest ATP World Tour doubles tournaments played (minimum 11), and if still tied, then,
 2. The most total points from the ATP World Tour 1000 mandatory tournaments and Barclays ATP World Tour Finals (Doubles), and if still tied, then,
 3. The highest number of points from one single ATP World Tour doubles tournament, then, if needed, the second highest, and so on
